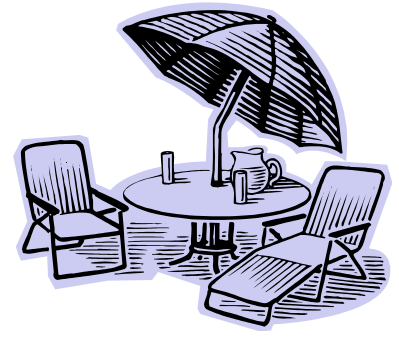

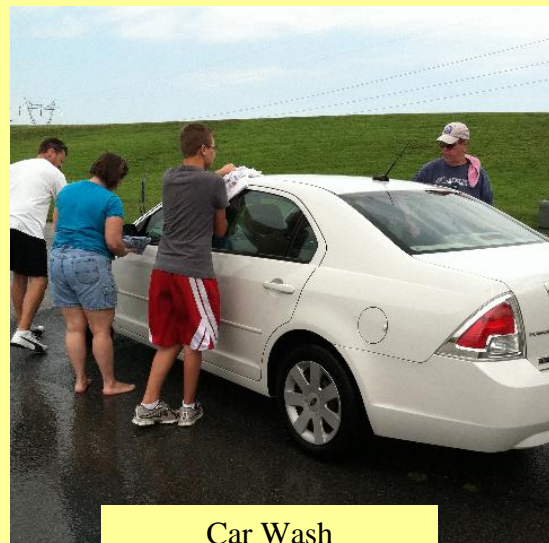
Reminders
